Q: What happens if an exchange rate changes while my transfer is in progress? A: The handling of exchange rate changes during a transfer depends on the app's policy. Some apps allow you to lock in a rate at the time you initiate the transfer, meaning the rate will not change regardless of market fluctuations. Others might operate with real-time rates that can adjust until the transaction is fully processed. Transparent apps will clearly state their policy on rate locking and changes, allowing you to make an informed decision before proceeding.
