• AUTOMATED CLEANUP (WITH CAUTION): SOME APPS CAN BE CONFIGURED TO AUTOMATICALLY DELETE FILES FROM THE DOWNLOADS FOLDER AFTER A CERTAIN PERIOD, BUT ALWAYS EXERCISE CAUTION AND ENSURE CRITICAL FILES ARE NOT

INADVERTENTI Y REMOVED.

- MANUAL REVIEW: MAKE IT A HABIT TO GO THROUGH YOUR DOWNLOADS FOLDER AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK. DELETE WHAT YOU NO LONGER NEED, AND MOVE IMPORTANT FILES TO THEIR DESIGNATED ORGANIZED LOCATIONS.
- EMPTY CACHE REGULARLY: WHILE NOT DIRECTLY FILE ORGANIZATION, CLEARING APP CACHES CAN FREE UP SIGNIFICANT SPACE AND PREVENT UNNECESSARY DATA ACCUMULATION.

Managing Duplicate Files

- **CLOUD ARCHIVING:** UTILIZE CLOUD STORAGE SERVICES THAT OFFER LOW-COST ARCHIVAL TIERS FOR LONG-TERM STORAGE.
- EXTERNAL STORAGE: FOR VERY LARGE ARCHIVES, CONSIDER TRANSFERRING THEM TO AN EXTERNAL HARD DRIVE OR NAS FOR SAFEKEEPING.
